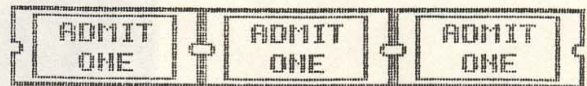
## Westward Ho in new Covered Wagon!
